BE HOLY

Joshua 5:13-5 "Now it came about when Joshua was by Jericho, that he lifted up his eyes and looked, and behold, a man was standing opposite him with his sword drawn in his hand, and Joshua went to him and said to him, 'Are you for us or for our adversaries?'

He said, 'No; rather I indeed come now as captain of the host of the Lord.' And Joshua fell on his face to the earth, and bowed down, and said to him, 'What has my lord to say to his servant?' The captain of the Lord's host said to Joshua, 'Remove your sandals from your feet, for the place where you are standing is holy.' And Joshua did so."

The living sacrifice – allow the Lord to burn up self/flesh – empty self and be filled with His Spirit—allow His passion to burn

In the same way that the Israelites brought a burnt offering, believers come to the altar to sacrifice **our self on the altar of God to receive His life.** "Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship. And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect." (Romans 12:1-2)

We come to the altar once to give ourselves to the Lord and to accept His sacrifice for our sins. After that initial transaction of accepting Jesus and receiving His Holy Spirit, we daily are given the opportunity to offer ourselves and what our flesh desires to the Lord and ask Him to transform our minds by His power so we will know what God's will is for our life. Then the Spirit can lead us. Romans 12:1-2

1 Peter 1:16"... because it is written, 'You shall be holy, for I am holy'."

How do we become holy vessels and vessels of honor for the Lord?

Deny self and be filled with the spirit

Then Jesus said to His disciples, 'If anyone wishes to come after Me, he must **deny himself, and take up his cross and follow Me**. For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it; but whoever loses his life for My sake will find it. For what will it profit a man if he gains the whole world and forfeits his soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul? For the Son of Man is going to come in the glory of His Father with His angels, and will then repay every man according to his deeds. Truly I say to you, there are some of those who are standing here who will not taste death until they see the Son of Man coming in His kingdom.'." (Matthew 16:21-28)

Using the Greek definition of man: 1-body, 2- soul, 3-spirit. "Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you entirely; and may your spirit and soul and body be preserved complete, without blame at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ." (1 Thessalonians 5:23)

How to become a functioning temple

Besides God's plan for us to dwell with Him in oneness, is God's desire to work through His Body to accomplish His eternal plans. In Isaiah 56:7 we read that Gentiles or the nations, along with Jews, are to come to God's holy mountain. "Even those I will bring to My holy mountain and make them joyful in My house of prayer. Their burnt offerings and their sacrifices will be acceptable on My altar; for **My house will be called a house of prayer for all the peoples**." The word 'house' is "probably from the root word meaning to build." (Strong's, # 1004) 'Prayer' (Strong's, #8605) "means intercession for someone." This house of prayer for all the peoples (Strong's, #5971) refers to "a people (as a congregated unit), a nation, a tribe,...a community;

the common people, human beings in general, the whole human race." God's people are to be praying for all peoples.

Because the Holy Spirit dwells with believers, we are not only to be the temple of God but also a house of prayer for all nations. Jesus referred to Isaiah 56:7 when He cleansed the temple and said the temple had become a den of robbers. (Mark 11:17) Because the Holy Spirit dwells with believers, we are the temple of God and are not to allow the temple, i.e. ourselves, to be robbed of the relationship the Lord desires to have with us, His plans and purposes for which He created us, and our role of being a house of prayer for all nations. Since we are not to rob God in any way (Malachi 3:6-12), we are surely not to rob Him in this way. When we do not allow the Holy Spirit in us to gie us His life and to work through us, we quench His Spirit. Then we do not bear fruit, we do not pray for the nations or for God's will to be done. At this juncture in our lives, we have joined the thief (Satan) who wants to rob us of our place in the Kingdom, our blessing and joy of being one with the Holy Spirit.

Being built as a house of prayer

Whether there are actual buildings or not, believers abiding in the Lord can be houses of prayer for all nations. As a house of prayer for all nations we can pray as at all times, for all the saints, in the Spirit.

In Hebrews 7:25: "Therefore He is able also to save forever those who draw near to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.". We know the Chief Intercessor is Jesus and He is our pattern for who we are and what our work is to be. When we follow in Jesus' steps we choose His work, which is to intercede for believers and unbelievers, whom He is bringing into His kingdom. "We are told in Isaiah 59:16 the Lord was surprised to see no on e interceding so He worked salvation. "And He (God) saw that there was no man, and was astonished that there was no one to intercede; then His own arm brought salvation to Him, and His righteousness upheld Him."

Believers find the pattern of doing what they **see** Jesus doing or in reading the Scriptures about what Jesus or the Father does. For the Father shows His children what He is doing and what He wants done because He loves them. "Therefore Jesus answered and was saying to them, 'Truly, truly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, unless it is **something He sees the Father doing**; for whatever the Father does, these things the Son also does in like manner. For the Father loves the Son, and shows Him all things that He Himself is doing; and the Father will show Him greater works than these, so that you will marvel." (John 5:19-20)

"Since the Lord your God walks in the midst of your camp to deliver you and to defeat your enemies before you, therefore your camp must be holy; and He must not see anything indecent among you or He will turn away from you." Deuteronomy 23:14

God establishes our hearts without blame in holiness

11 Now may our God and Father Himself and Jesus our Lord direct our way to you;

12 and may the Lord cause you to increase and abound in love for one another, and for all people, just as we also do for you;

13 so that He >>>may establish your hearts without blame in holiness before our God and Father at the coming of our Lord Jesus with all His saints. [1 Thessalonians 3:11-13]:

Against the Lord and against His Christ.' [spiritual enemies in high places (Ephesians 6:12) are against God and Christ and Christ's people. However, when a person receives Christ, then 'Christ is in you, the hope of glory' (Colossians 1:27) Christ leads His people in victory through His Spirit and by His power. (2 Corinthians 2:14)]

27 "For truly in this city there were gathered together against Your holy servant Jesus, whom You anointed, both Herod and Pontius Pilate, along with the Gentiles and the peoples of Israel,

28 to do whatever Your hand and Your purpose predestined to occur. 29 "And now, Lord, take note of their threats, and grant that Your bond-servants may speak Your word with all confidence,

30 while You extend Your hand to heal, and signs and wonders take place through the name of Your holy servant Jesus."

31 And when they had prayed, the place where they had gathered together was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak the word of God with boldness.

Isaiah 56:7-8

Their burnt offerings and their sacrifices will be acceptable on My altar;

For My house will be called a house of prayer for all the peoples."

8 The Lord God, who gathers the dispersed of Israel, declares,

"Yet others I will gather to them, to those already gathered."

God is creator and Maker and what He creates and makes is good. He sustains life and gives creation life. However, God is set on destruction of anything and everything that causes us to sin or builds iniquities in nations or from one generation to the next. He is calling his people to be holy. As Creator God, He wants the web site to be a holy place that remains good in His sight.

PRAYER STRATEGY

Have faith in Jesus to protect His people, to give them strength to do what He has said and boldness for each act of prayer. Through the power of the Spirit and the hand of Jesus may God bring His words of truth and wisdom; give life, light, and agape' type of willful-love; salvation of the nations; healing, restoration, signs, and wonders in our day.

Principle 3: Lift our voices in one accord & watch for His signs and wonders taking place
